

Using Xbox or PlayStation to access Home Learning Materials



An alternative method of accessing remote learning during times of lockdown is to use a games console.

Xbox

1. Plug a keyboard into the Xbox USB slot or use a wireless keyboard. If these are not available you can use the onscreen keyboard and provided **Xbox controller**. (this is time consuming when trying to type a lot)
2. Go in to **My Games and Apps**
3. Find the **Microsoft Edge app** and select it.
4. Type in the school website/class charts/remote learning platform or site that your school uses.
5. Log in **as you would in school**.
6. You can then access your work through Google Classroom or OneDrive and use key packages including:
 - G suite
 - Word
 - Microsoft Teams
 - Excel
 - PowerPoint
 - Your school e-mails
7. To move around you use the Xbox controller or it would be easier to plug in a mouse

PlayStation

1. Identify the PlayStation internet browser icon (it is WWW with dots around it)
2. Press the **PlayStation logo** on the controller
3. Go to the **library** and find options for games and applications
4. Go into **applications** and you will find the **internet browser**.
5. Type in the school website/class charts/remote learning platform or site that your school uses and log in as you would in school.
6. Log in **as you would in school**
7. You can then access your work through Google Classroom or OneDrive and use key packages including:
 - G suite
 - Word
 - Microsoft Teams
 - Excel
 - PowerPoint
 - Your school e-mails
7. To move around you use the controller or it would be easier to plug in a mouse
