Christmas Parties

Each class will be having their own Christmas party this year:

- Nursery- Wednesday December 16th a.m.
- Reception- Tuesday December 15th p.m.
- Year 1 – Wednesday December 16th p.m.
- Year 2- Tuesday December 15th a.m.
- Year 3- Monday December 14th a.m./p.m.
- Year 4- Monday December 14th a.m./p.m.
- Year 5- Thursday December 17th p.m.
- Year 6 Thursday December 17th a.m.

The children will need to come into school dressed in their party clothes for the whole day this year so you might need to bear this in mind when deciding on outfits and shoes. The children will not be able to share party food so they will need to bring in their own packed party tea. Some classes will have their party in the hall in the morning session and some in the afternoon session. However, their whole day will be devoted to Christmas activities and treats so the timing of the party itself will not matter. Your child's class teacher will also write to you about party arrangements nearer the day.

Christmas Cards

The children will only be allowed to send Christmas cards to their own class this year. They will need to bring their cards in by Friday December 11th at the latest. The cards will be put in their class posting box to quarantine, and their teacher will give them out before the end of term when the children can take them home to open.

Christmas Performance

As we cannot invite you into school this year for Christmas plays and concerts, the children have been practising Christmas songs and carols to sing for you. Each class has prepared two/three Christmas carols/songs which will be performed and recorded in school next week. The recording will be put up on the website for you to view in the last week of term. If you do not want your child to be filmed for this purpose, please let Mrs. Griffiths know and she will inform the class teachers.

Infant Christmas lunch will be on Thursday 10th December, and Junior Christmas lunch will be on Thursday 17th December.
