

<b>Module 1: Unit 1: Religious Understanding</b>	
Story Sessions: Let the Children Come	The children will learn that they are created by God out of love and for love.
<b>Module 2: Unit 1: Religious Understanding</b>	
Session 1: God Loves You	This session tells the story of 'The Prodigal Son' to show that God loves us, and nothing we can do will stop Him from loving us.
<b>Module 2: Unit 2: Personal Relationships</b>	
Session 1: Special People	This session will help children to identify the 'special people' in their lives and what makes them special.
Session 2: Treat Others Well...	This session investigates how their behaviour can affect other people.
Session 3: ... and Say Sorry	Children will learn that our behaviour can not only upset other people, but it can hurt God too. They will be given an opportunity to reflect on their own experiences and to give and receive forgiveness.
<b>Module 2: Unit 3: Keeping Safe</b>	
Session 1: Being Safe	This session helps children to recognise safe and unsafe situations in real life and online.
Session 2: Good and Bad Secrets	In this session, children will learn the difference between good secrets that are safe to keep, and bad secrets that are unsafe to keep.
Session 3: Physical Contact	Using the PANTS resources from the NSPCC the children will know that they are entitled to bodily privacy and that there are different people we can trust for help.
Session 4: Harmful Substances	The children will learn that medicines are drugs, but not all drugs are good for us and that alcohol and tobacco are harmful substances.
Session 5: Can You Help Me? Part.1	this session explores what makes a situation a 999 emergency.
Session 6: Can You Help Me? Part.2	This session introduces children to the principles of basic First Aid.
<b>Module 3: Unit 1: Religious Understanding</b>	
Session 1: Three In One	The children will be introduced to the concept of the Holy Trinity and think about what the Holy Trinity means for them.
Session 2: Who Is My Neighbour?	Through the story of The Good Samaritan, children will learn who their neighbour is – everyone!
<b>Module 3: Unit 2: Living in the Wider World</b>	
Session 1: The Communities We Live In	In this session, children will learn about the different communities that they are part of, both local and global. They will think about what it means to belong to a community and the rights and responsibilities that come with it.
