

<b>Module 1: Unit 1 – Religious Understanding</b>	
Story Sessions: Let the Children Come	The children will learn that they are created by God out of love and for love.
<b>Module 1: Unit 2: Me, My Body, My Health</b>	
Session 1: I Am Unique	Children will be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between fictional people and each other as things that make us unique and special.
Session 2: Girls and Boys	This session is all about our celebrating our God-given bodies and the things they enable us to do! Children will be encouraged to notice similarities and celebrate differences between girls and boys on physical, emotional and spiritual levels.
Session 3: Clean and Healthy (1)	This session teaches children how to take care of their bodies.
Session 4: Clean and Healthy (2)	Continued from previous session
<b>Module 1: Unit 3: Emotional Wellbeing</b>	
Session 1: Feelings, Likes and Dislikes	Children will realise that we all have different feelings at different times, and different likes and dislikes too.
Session 2: Feeling Inside Out	Children will take part in activities to help them understand and articulate their own feelings and how other people’s feelings might differ from theirs.
Session 3: Super Susie Gets Angry	The children will help Super Susie through experiencing strong feelings for the first time. They will learn more about the consequences of choices and what to do when it all goes wrong.
<b>Module 1: Unit 4: Life Cycles</b>	
Session 1: The Cycle of Life	The session looks at the specifics of the human life cycle, from childhood to old age, and children will be encouraged to celebrate how they have already changed and grown.
<b>Module 3: Unit 1: Religious Understanding</b>	
Session 1: Three In One	The children will be introduced to the concept of the Holy Trinity and think about what the Holy Trinity means for them.
Session 2: Who Is My Neighbour?	Through the story of The Good Samaritan, children will learn who their neighbour is – everyone!
<b>Module 3: Unit 2: Living in the Wider World</b>	
Session 1: The Communities We Live In	In this session, children will learn about the different communities that they are part of, both local and global. They will think about what it means to belong to a community and the rights and responsibilities that come with it.
