I am writing to inform you of the outcome of the OFSTED inspection that took place at St Bede's RC Primary school on the 14th and 15th of May 2024. I am delighted to tell you all that the final report from OFSTED has been received and the school has been judged outstanding in all areas.

It is important to acknowledge that this is a tremendous achievement, considering that an outstanding judgement puts St Bede's in a small elite group of schools across the country. It indicates that, through their comprehensive and extensive two day inspection, every aspect of the school the inspectors looked at (Leadership and Management, Behaviour and Attitudes, Quality of Education, Personal Development and Early Years Provision) was judged as outstanding and no areas were judged as needing improvement. I and other members of the Governing Body received feedback from the inspector and she could not have been more positive and appreciative of her visit to our school. It was particularly pleasing to see the hard work and dedication of everyone associated with the school recognised by the inspectors on their visit.

Particular praise was awarded to the pupils whose exemplary behaviour, commitment to learning and pride in the school was evident. They also recognised pupils joy in learning and expanding their knowledge in all areas. I would like to thank all your children for their outstanding behaviour, kindness and exceptional qualities that make our school outstanding. You all must be very proud. As the OFSTED report states "Pupils behaviour is impeccable, they are kind, responsible and respectful. Pupils show a deep appreciation of the many differences that exist between people"

I would also like to thank all the teachers and support staff for their tireless hard work and commitment to making St Bede's an exceptionally nurturing environment for all its pupils to grow and develop all their individual talents in a safe, calm and positive space. As inspectors noted

Staff share leaders relentless pursuit of excellence. They are proud to work at the school. Staff morale is high. They feel well supported. "
