

## Pupil Led 'Let Us Pray 2gether' Celebration of the Word

The children chose the themes of 'Forgiveness'.

All children will take a role in the COTW, reading out one of the cards and explaining to their peers how they can actively share in celebration.

The children planned their child led COTW, assigning each person a role, choosing to:

**Gather** - as the children gathered in the classroom after their lunch break, the children showed an act of kindness to the person that sat to the right and/or left of them by giving them a hug, a high-five, a fist bump, or said something nice about them.

Before listening to The Word, the children wrote down the name of a person they needed to forgive. The class teacher then walked around with a basket, the children crumpled up the piece of paper and put it in the basket to symbolise they had forgiven that person.

The children then **Listened to the Word**; 'Forgive other people and your Father will forgive you' – Mark 11:25.

- **Response to the Word** – the children then held a glass bead in their hand and reflected quietly on things they had done wrong this past week. Children asked God for his forgiveness when they placed the marble in a bowl.

**Mission** – the children were asked to give a kind or inspirational message to another pupil in the school before they left that day.
