

Year 1 Mental Arithmetic Test

Date of test: 5th March 2026

This week's maths target:

Learn the 10 times table.

Count in tens from ten and back to zero.

10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100, 110, 120

The children are practising their 10 times table this week. The children will have to be able to recite the full 10 times table from 1×10 to 12×10 .

Activities:

Practise chanting in 10's then encourage them to say the full multiplication sentence;

1×10 is 10

2×10 is 20

3×10 is 30

4×10 is 40

5×10 is 50

6×10 is 60

7×10 is 70

8×10 is 80

9×10 is 90

10×10 is 100

11×10 is 110

12×10 is 120
