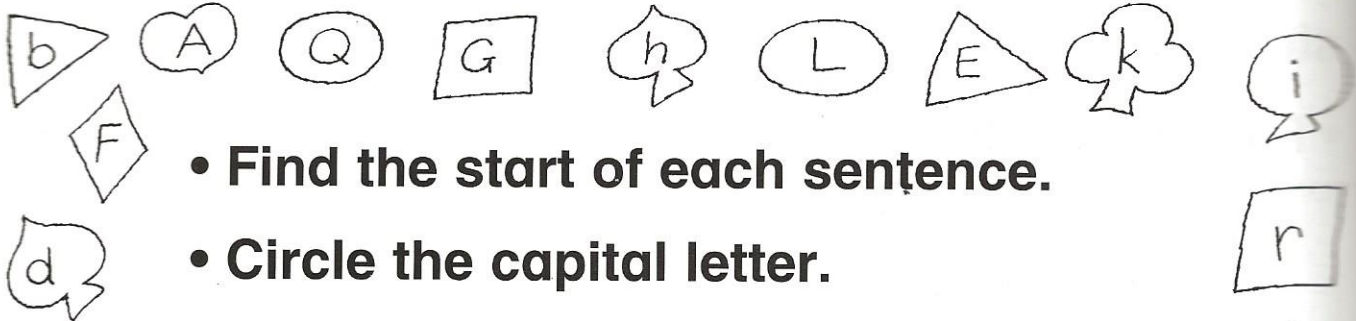


# Capital letters

- Colour the shapes which have capital letters.



- Find the start of each sentence.

- Circle the capital letter.

A princess has a ball made of gold. One day she plays with her ball by a pond. The ball falls in the water.

The princess can not get her ball. The water is too deep.

A frog comes. He says he will get the ball. But the princess must give him a kiss first.

- What do you think happens next?
- Write sentences to tell the rest of the story.
- Start them with capital letters.
- End them with full stops.



**Teachers' note** During the introductory session, revise upper- and lower-case letters; write a lower-case letter and invite the children to write the capital letter. Using a shared text, ask the children to point out the capital letters, and ask them which ones begin new sentences.
